### **HOW TO LIVE MAY AS A TRUE MARIAN MONTH**

The month of May encourages us to think and speak in a special way about Mama Mary. For this is her month. Thus, the time of the year when the rhythms of nature inspire renewed hope and joy becomes an echo of the supernatural life that divine grace pours into us.

Mary is the New Eve, Mother of God, Co-Redemptrix and Mediatrix. She is the Queen of Heaven. Devotion to Mary is not optional - it is an integral part of Catholic Spirituality. As St. Louis de Montfort said, "To Jesus Through Mary".

Some recommended practices that can make this May more devotional and fruitful are: 1) Daily recitation of the Holy Rosary 2) Consecration or Renewal to Mary 3) Offering Flowers to Mary 4) Reading and meditating on Marian apparitions 5) Participating in processions and public devotions.
