THE HOLY TRINITY: In Catholic teaching, the Holy Spirit is the **Third Person of the Holy Trinity** - fully God, equal with the Father and the Son, not merely a force or symbol.

In a nutshell:

Who is the Holy Spirit? The Holy Spirit is God's living presence and love active in the world and in people. Catholics believe the one God exists eternally as: Father, Son (Jesus Christ), Holy Spirit.

What does the Holy Spirit do? The Holy Spirit: Gives spiritual life and holiness, Guides the Church into truth, Inspires Scripture, Strengthens believers through grace, Distributes spiritual gifts, Helps people pray and grow closer to God, Convicts people of sin and leads them to repentance.

Biblical foundations: Catholics point to many passages, especially: Jesus' promise of the "Advocate" or "Helper" in John 14-16, The descent of the Spirit at Pentecost in Acts 2, The Spirit descending on Jesus at His baptism.

Symbols of the Holy Spirit: Common symbols include Dove, Fire, Wind/breath, Oil, Water.

Role in the Sacraments: We believe the Holy Spirit acts especially through the sacraments: Baptism brings new spiritual life. Confirmation strengthens with gifts of the Spirit. Eucharist transforms bread and wine into Christ's presence.

The Gifts of the Holy Spirit: Traditionally seven gifts are emphasized: Wisdom, Understanding, Counsel, Fortitude, Knowledge, Piety, Fear of the Lord.

The Fruits of the Spirit: Signs of the Spirit working in a person include love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control (Galatians 5).

Simple Catholic summary: The Holy Spirit is God dwelling within believers, guiding, transforming, and empowering them to live like Christ and remain united with God and the Church.
